



CONTEST RULES

ENGINEERING FOR THE BEES

1. Contest description and eligibility

The “Engineering for the Bees” contest is an integral part of the promotional campaign for the engineering profession carried out by the Ordre des ingénieurs du Québec (OIQ) in association with the Ordre des ingénieurs du Québec Foundation (OIQF). This contest gives young people a chance to use engineering by building a habitat for bees with all types of materials. Participants must take a photo of their habitat and fill out the entry form on line. This contest is reserved for students aged 12 to 18 who attend an educational institution (private or public secondary school or CEGEP) in Québec.

2. Contest entry

Participants must fill out the entry form on line and upload the photo of the habitat they built. The entry form is available at www.placepourtoi.ca. The contest is accessible only through the Internet.

3. Contest entry deadlines

4. Method of awarding the prizes and conditions

The winners will be determined by random draw.

To receive their prize, the participants whose names are randomly drawn will have to provide a school transcript or enrolment confirmation proving that they are enrolled at a secondary school or CEGEP. They will be officially declared winners as soon as they have sent their school transcript or enrolment confirmation to the OIQ.



4.1. Number, brief description and value of each prize

Three (3) \$500 cash prizes will be drawn.

5. Location, dates and times of the random draws

Each draw will be performed by the Professional Development Department of the Ordre des ingénieurs du Québec at the OIQ's headquarters, located at 1801 McGill College Avenue, 6th floor, Montreal H3A 2N4.

6. Communication with the prize winners

The participants whose names are randomly drawn will be notified by e-mail or phone. As soon as they have provided proof that they actually meet the selection criteria, they will be officially declared winners. Their first names, project photo, a brief description, and the name of their school will then be posted on the Placepourtoi.ca Facebook page.

7. Delivery of the prizes to the winners

The OIQ will attempt to contact the winners on the same day of the draw. It will try again after two (2) business days. The winners have ten (10) business days to answer by e-mail or phone. After 10 days, winners who have not replied will be disqualified and the OIQ will perform another random draw. The prizes will be mailed to the winners within four weeks of the random draw.



8. General rules

- The winners will be determined by random draw and not selected by a jury.
- Participants may win a prize only once.
- The entry periods are separate. Participants may enter the contest in all three periods, but may win only once.
- This contest is organized by the Ordre des ingénieurs du Québec. OIQ employees and representatives and the individuals with whom they are domiciled may not enter this contest.
- A dispute over the conduct or organization of a publicity contest may be submitted to the Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux for a ruling. A dispute over the awarding of a prize may be submitted to the Régie solely for the purpose of helping the parties reach a settlement.
