- Plan and lead timber processing operations at plants according to the specifications received from management.
 - Estimate the costs of producing products like milled wood, particleboard, furniture, and wood-based construction systems.

Design wood sawing, veneering, drying, machining and preservation processes at plants using their knowledge of industrial engineering, material resistance, thermodynamics, mechanics, physics, chemistry and the anatomical features of wood.

Can design and market innovative products made from wood or composite materials.
