

CONTEST RULES

Place pour toi

1. Contest Description and Eligibility

The « place pour toi » contest is an integral part of the engineering promotional campaign of the Ordre des ingénieurs du Québec (OIQ, hereinafter "the Organizer").

This contest is designed to help young people find the answer to their question by browsing the website www.placepourtoi.ca. Participants must fill out their form online and answer the question: in what year was the optical fibre deployed in Quebec? <https://www.placepourtoi.ca/en/ingenierie-a-travers-le-temps/1980-deployment-of-optical-fibre-in-quebec/>

This contest is reserved for students aged 11 to 22 who attend a private or public secondary school or college in Quebec.

Only one contest entry is allowed per person.

2. Contest Entry Method

Participants must fill out a form online and provide the correct answer to the question. The form has been posted online by the Ordre des ingénieurs du Québec at <https://www.placepourtoi.ca/en/contest/>. The contest is accessible only through the Internet.

No purchase or payment necessary. To enter the contest, simply fill out the form online.

3. Contest Entry Deadline

4. Method and Conditions of Awarding the Prizes

The prize recipients will be determined by random draw.

To receive their prize, the young people whose names are randomly drawn will have to provide a school transcript or enrolment confirmation to prove that they attend a secondary school or college in Quebec. Once they have provided this information, the recipients will be officially declared the winners.

4.1. Number, Brief Description and Value of Each Prize

Nine prizes will be drawn in total. There will be one draw.

These are the nine prizes that will be drawn:

- A pair of Ferreol brand skis with binding, delivery and adjustment. In addition to a virtual meeting with one of the founders to explain the engineering in the design of a pair of Skis – value of approximately \$1,400. **
- Five gift cards from a bookstore – value of \$100 per card. One gift card per winner
- Instant print camera – 200\$ value
- Tablet – 800\$ value
- Wireless headphones – 350\$ value

** Note that the winner of the pair of skis must provide the following additional information:

- Height
- Weight
- Age
- Level of ski experience
- Model and size of the boot (in mm), if applicable
- Availability to virtually meet the co-founder

5. Location, Date and Time of the Random Draws

The draw will be held at the headquarters of the Ordre des ingénieurs du Québec, located at 1801 McGill College Avenue, 6th floor, Montreal H3A 2N4. The draw will be conducted by the OIQ's Profession Development Department.

6. Communication with the Prize Recipients

The participants whose names are randomly drawn will be notified by email or telephone. Once the proof of their eligibility has been provided, they will be officially declared recipients. Their first and last names, photos and the names of their educational institutions will then be posted on the social media of Placepourtoi.ca (Facebook and Instagram).

7. Delivery of the Prizes to the Recipients

The Organizer will attempt to contact the recipients on the same day of the draw. It will try again after two business days. Recipients will have ten business days to answer by email or phone. After that period of time has passed, recipients who have not replied will be declared disqualified by the Organizer, which will conduct another random draw. The prizes will be mailed to the recipients within four weeks of the random draw.

8. General Rules

- Recipients will be determined by random draw and not by a jury.
- **Participants must enter the correct information** on the registration platform. The Organizer may not be held responsible for any problem arising from an error in the email address or telephone number entered.
- This contest is organized by the Ordre des ingénieurs du Québec. Employees of the OIQ, its representatives and the people domiciled at the same address may not enter this contest.
- A dispute over the organization or conduct of a promotional contest may be submitted to the Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux for a ruling. A dispute concerning the awarding of a prize may be submitted to the Régie solely for the purpose of helping the parties reach a settlement.
